

SCHUYLKILL RIVER TRAIL

RULES AND REGULATIONS (APPLIES TO BERKS AND SCHUYLKILL COUNTIES)

The trail is open from dawn to dusk.

Speed Limit 15 MPH.

Permitted Trail Uses: Walking, running, biking, skiing, horseback riding. Pennsylvania law requires all bike riders and passengers under the age of twelve to wear a helmet.

Use the trail at your own risk: The trail passes through changing natural landscapes that may create temporary hazardous conditions.

No Motorized Vehicles Allowed: Except emergency and maintenance vehicles, mobility devices and some e-bikes.

E-bikes: An e-bike is permitted on the trail if it has a motor less than 750 Watts and does not have the capacity to be self-propelled. E-bikes may not exceed the 15 MPH speed limit.

Trail Etiquette: Keep right except when passing. Warn others of your intent to pass. Pedestrians yield to horses, bicyclists yield to pedestrians and horses. Please remove horse droppings from the trail surface if possible.

Please do not litter. Carry-in, carry-out. There are no trash cans on the trail.

Private Lands: Please respect the rights and privacy of adjoining property owners. Please do not leave the trail except at clearly designated access points.

Pets: Pets must be leashed. Please pick up after your pet.

Bridges: Do not fish, jump, dive from or climb on trail bridges.

Road Crossings: Trail users must come to a complete stop and look both ways at all road crossings.

Alcoholic Beverages: Alcoholic beverages are prohibited on the trail and in the parking lots.

Firearms and Hunting: Loaded Firearms are prohibited on the trail. Firearms may not be discharged from or across the trail or parking lots. Trail users should use caution during hunting season. Hunting may be permissible in areas near the trail. Orange vests or other brightly colored clothing should be worn during hunting seasons.

Emergencies: Dial 911.
