THINGS TO DO COSAS PARA HACER

¡Camina en el paseo acuático sobre el Río Schuylkill! The Schuylkill Banks Boardwalk offers breathtaking views along a 2,000-foot-long path that extends the Schuylkill River Trail from Locust Street to South Street. Pedestrians, runners and cyclists can literally walk or ride over the river and see amazing Philadelphia skyline views. ▶

¡Visita este mundialmente famoso museo al lado del sendero del Río Schuylkill! The Philadelphia Museum of Art is the cultural Heart of the city and Fairmount Park's famed Water Works—a National Historic Landmark—is at the foot of the museum. Both are accessible from the SRT.

¡Pasee a través de un jardín histórico! America's birthplace of gardening, **Bartram's Gardens**, is a 50-acre public garden where visitors are welcome to stroll through the fragrant flower gardens and visit the riverside meadows. ▶

¡Ve la sede de George Washington! With more than 3,600 acres of rolling hills and miles of well-worn hiking and biking trails, **Valley Forge National Historical Park** is a popular destination. ▶

¡Observe un bloqueo activo de canal! Schuylkill Canal Park/Lock60 boasts wildflower walks, birding paths, canal era historic features, a favorite local fishing spot and public boat launches. This site is home to the popular five-mile water "loop trail".

¡A 200+ acre estate, the John James Audubon Center at Mill Grove, is the site of the first home of American naturalist John James Audubon. It is now a haven for birds and wildlife, and the property boasts more than seven miles of trails plus the new Audubon museum overlooking the Perkiomen Creek.

¡Ve a cebras, jaguares, nutrias y más! **Elmwood Park Zoo** is dedicated to animal conservation and is home to dozens of wild and endangered species that roam the 16-acre zoo. Meet mammals and reptiles, and catch a show at the theater or ride on the animal-themed carousel. ▶

¡Observe raptores grandes y asombrosas vistas de montañas! **Hawk Mountain Sanctuary** is a wild bird sanctuary located along the Appalachian flyway in Kempton, PA. It is a world-renowned outdoor destination for hikers, birdwatchers, and nature enthusiasts and an amazing place to see raptors. Hawk Mountain offers 8+ miles of well-marked hiking trails which vary in length and difficulty. ▶

¡Celebre el arte local! **GoggleWorks Center for the Arts** is a community art and cultural resource center located in Reading, PA just steps from the SRT. It features teaching studios and artist studios, as well as several galleries, a film theater, a bar and restaurant and a store featuring handcrafted works by over 200 local artists.

*Home to **Berks Nature's** headquarters, Eco-Camp and Nature Preschool, the newly renovated **Nature Place** sits among nearly 100 acres in Reading's Angelica Creek Park. Take a stroll through the dog-friendly wetland trails and get your hands dirty in the teaching demonstration gardens. Children are welcome and encouraged to run free with their imaginations in the Nature Play Zone. ▶*

¡Aprenda haciendo! Learn by Doing! For more than a century, the **Reading Public Museum** located in West Reading has been at the forefront of hands-on learning. This museum provides rich, tactile experiences to spark curiosity and learning for visitors of all ages in science, art, and history.

*The **Reading Railroad Heritage Museum**, located in Hamburg, is dedicated to the preservation of the Reading Railroad and is owned and operated by the Reading Company Technical & Historical Society. It features several pieces of retired rolling stock, including Blueliners and Budd Rail Diesel Cars, as well as model trail layouts and railroad memorabilia. ▶*

¡Visite el campo de entrenamiento de Muhammad Ali! **Fighter's Heaven** in Deer Lake, PA, is the former training camp of Muhammad Ali. The venue has been preserved and restored as a destination that serves to educate about the life of the three-time heavyweight champion of the world.

*Experience nearly 200 years of American brewing history with a tour of the **Yuengling Brewery** in Pottsville. Tours are free and include a beer sample (for those over 21). ▶*

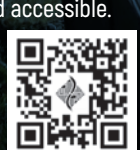
TRAIL ETIQUETTE

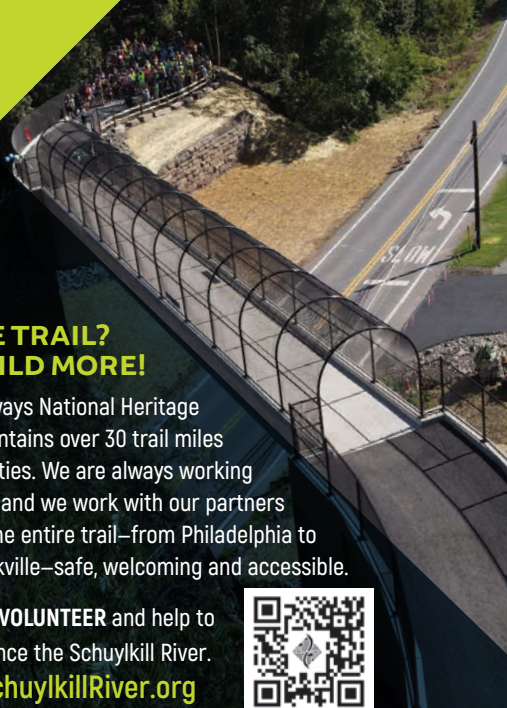
